PUBLIC MEETING

Work is due to commence on a new 5 acre Cemetery on the open ground at the end of Thorner Lane, near the junction with the A64 York Road. Leeds City Council is consulting about the Cemetery, and the future use of the rest of the 104 acre site.

Proposals currently include the relocation of the Council facility at Redhall, including the Nursery, waste re-cycling plant and sports pitches.
